


## **EXAMPLES of how a WRECK DIVE SITE can be ENHANCED**



- Studies have shown that steel ships and structures will experience flaking which means
  organisms attached will fall off with the flakes of rust. \*Studies have also found that colonization
  is greatest on concrete, followed by rock, rubber and then steel.
- Concrete Reef Balls complement wrecks and increase diversity by providing important missing structure and substrate.
- There are unlimited possibilities for how Reef Balls may be used around wrecks whether for fishing or diving.
